MAN'S ADVERSARY, THE DEVIL 1 Peter 5:8

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The Bible doctrine of hell and the devil is unpopular in some quarters, w/ some denying both.
 - A. Some accuse mentioning these subjects as scare tactics to enforce unreasonable behavior
- 2. Gospel preachers cannot allow public opinion to dictate their subject matter (Gal 1:10).

BODY:

1. THE BIBLE REVEALS HIM AS A REAL, DISTINCT PERSONALITY

- A. The Bible uses pronouns: "he, him and "his" in making reference to the devil (Jn 8:44).
- B. Jesus called him a "murderer" and a "liar" (Jn 8:44).
- C. God confronted and talked to him (Gen 3:14, 15; Job 1:8; 2:2).
- D. Jesus confronted and talked to him (Mt 4:1-10).
- E. Called an "adversary", and seen as man's greatest opponent (1 Pet 5:8).
- F. Called a "roaring lion" speaks of the strength/fierceness of his attacks (Job 1:13-21; 2:7).
- G. He is called a serpent because of his subtlety and craftiness (Gen 3:1; 2 Cor 11:3).
 - 1. All these terms describe a real being, not a figment of someone's imagination.

2. WHAT DOES HE DO?

- A. He tempts us to disobey as he tempted Jesus (Mt 4:1-10; 1 Jn 2:15-17).
- B. He hinders the gospel (1 The 2:18).
- C. He steals away the Word of God out of man's hearts (Mt 13:19).
- D. He sows tares (false doctrine) among the good seed (truth) (Mt 13:38, 39).
- E. He "turns some aside after him" (1 Tim 5:15).
- F. He will get you to betray the Lord if you will allow him (Lk 22:3).

3. HOW DOES HE ACCOMPLISH HIS WORK?

- A. He tries to get an advantage over us (2 Cor 2:11).
- B. He has many devices (2 Cor 2:11).
- C. He has many "wiles" (tricks) (Eph 6:11).
- D. He will appear as "an angel of light" (2 Cor 11:13-15).
- E. Deceit, subtilty, procrastination and peer pressure are his tools.
 - 1. Awareness is a must, not an oversight.

4. HOW CAN WE DEFEND AGAINST HIM?

- A. Resist him (Jas 4:7; 1 Pet 5:8, 9).
- B. Store up and use scripture against him (Psa 119:11; Mt 4:1-10).
- C. Put on the whole armor of God (Eph 6:11).
- D. Know the difference between good and evil (Isa 7:15).

5. WHAT'S HIS END?

A. He will be cast into everlasting fire (Mt 25:41; Rev 20:10).

CONCLUSION:

1. Though a formidable foe, he can be defeated and resisted (Php 4:13).




SCATTERED AND ALONE?

Just shortly before His arrest and crucifixion, Jesus told His disciples "Indeed the hour is coming, yes, has now come, that you will be scattered, each to His own, and will leave me alone" (Jn 16:32a). We can all certainly relate to both sides of that statement today can't we? We have all been scattered, each to his/her own home for the time being, no longer able to enjoy the sweet fellowship and togetherness that we have become so accustomed to, and maybe even taken a little for granted at times over the years. Subsequently, many of us have perhaps even begun to feel very alone due to our physical isolation from one another... But hear Jesus' next words very clearly: "And yet I am not alone, because the Father is with Me" (Jn 16:32b).

Jesus, going into the worst and most horrific event of His entire existence, knew, and took total peace and comfort in accepting if no one else, His love could/would be there with Him. 
