WHO IS ON THE LORD'S SIDE? EXODUS 32:26

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. In its early days, Israel was going through its birth pangs as a nation, God led them to Mt. Sinai where they would be given their law. Three prerequisites to any kingdom include: a king, territory and law.
 - A. With God as their King and Canaan as their soon-to-be-conquered territory, all that remained were rules of conduct for the new kingdom.
- 2. When, after forty days, Moses returned from the mountain with the stone tablets upon which had been written the Ten Commandments by the finger of God, he found the people engaged in idolatrous worship to a golden calf.
 - A. In righteous indignation, Moses shattered the tablets at the foot of the mountain.
 - B. Then, burned the golden calf, ground it into power, scattered it over the surface of the water and made the people drink it (Exo 32:19, 20).
 - 1. When Moses saw the people were getting out of control, he stood at the gate of the camp and cried out, saying, "Whoever is for the Lord, come to me!" (v26).
 - A. The Levites, perhaps afraid to oppose their head, Aaron, now rallied to Moses' side, bringing Judgment to the sinning people (v27).
 - 2. Three thousand men fell that day in the fury of God's judgment (v28).
 - A. How could they so quickly forget the God who had provided such marvelous deliverance?

BODY:

1. ARE WE ON THE LORD'S SIDE NOW?

- A. Centuries later, on the first Pentecost following the resurrection and ascension of Christ, another kingdom was brought into existence (Ac 2:14-40).
- B. Peter delivered a message centered on Jesus (whom they had crucified), had been made "...both Lord and Christ" (Ac 2:36) and "...they were pricked in their heart" (Ac 2:37b).
 - 1. Jesus had been crowned "King of kings" (Rev 17:14).
 - A. But, in addition to a king, a kingdom needs territory (Jn 21:16, 17; Ac 20:17-38).
- C. Christ's kingdom is not of this world (Jn 18:36).
 - 1. His kingdom is in the hearts and minds of His People (Lk 17:21).
 - 2. Finally, there is the matter of a law. A kingdom must have laws by which it is governed.
 - A. Isaiah described the coming of the Messianic kingdom saying the law would go "forth from Zion and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem" (Isa 2:3).
 - B. This law did not come through Moses; but through Jesus, the Son of God (Jn 1:1, 14, 17).
 - 1. It was not received from the top of a mountain nor accompanied by the death of 3000, but from heaven by the rejoicing of those giving their hearts/lives to their new king (Ac 2:41).
- D. Paul, like Moses, was amazed how some had so quickly desert their Deliverer (Gal 1:6).
 - 1. As Moses asked, "Who is on the Lords' side?" (Exo 32:26), so also Christ asks His Disciples to faithfully align themselves with His Cause (Jn 14:15).
 - 2. The pressure to conform to the thinking/behavior of the world and our tendency to forget about the things of great Spiritual Significance instead of focusing on things which can be seen, felt and experienced with the natural senses.
 - A. All of this calls us to count the cost of our discipleship firmly placing ourselves in the camp of Christ Jesus. Sometimes it can be confusing for us to know who is truly on the Lord's Side.
 - 3. There are no uniforms in the Lord's Army. No special insignias, badges, wrist bands or necklaces.
 - A. We can know by their fruit as well as their love for one another (Mt 7:15-20; Jn 13:34, 35).
