We, as God's People, are described in a similar, Spiritually method, approach and style (Mt 5:14-16; Rom 2:19, 20; 2 Cor 6:14; Eph 5:8-14; Php 2:14-16; 1 The 5:5; Heb 12:6-12).

Christ Jesus, the Light of the world (Jn 1:4-9; 3:19; 8:12; 9:5; 12:35; Lk 1:78, 79; 2:32; Ac 13:47; 26:23), has shone His LOVE and GRACE upon us by saving us, so we in turn, can reflect by utilizing what He has given and shine His Light of HOPE into the dark world around us.


Let's face it, the world is in a very dark and threatening place as they have always been (even though some

see it differently, but do not be alarmed or mislead because the world is the enemy of the LORD (Jn 15:19; Rom 12:2; Jas 4:4; 1 Jn 2:15-17; 5:4, 5, 10).

Even we, as God's chosen and elect by obedience can lose our hope, shine and luster, if we take our eyes off of Him by becoming anxious in our own minds (Mt 6:24; Lk 16:13; Rom 1:21-23, 28; Gal 1:10; Eph 2:2; Col 3:1, 2; 1 Tim 6:10). If that's the case with us, can you even begin to imagine the despair, darkness and devastating hopelessness of those without God and His Word at this or any other time (Rom 3:25; Ac 17:30; 26:17, 18; Gal 4:8; 1 Cor 1:21; 2 Cor 4:4; Eph 2:11-22; 4:18; 2 The 2:14; Heb 10:31; 11:34)?

NOW is the <u>TIME</u>...to share with your family, friends and neighbors thru any avenue plausible, the everlasting HOPE one has in Christ Jesus. It is our PRAYER people will be more open to the LOVE of the gospel and willing to adhere to God's Plan (Rom 8:18, 28, 35; 2 The 1:6-10; 1 Pet 1:7, 8).

Seeking truth, we find Christians in the New Testament from the book of history being converted. They were scattered, unable to assemble because of the present danger, as a congregation in Jerusalem, God shined light into an area of darkness (Ac 8:1-8). What was the outcome? Preaching God's Word despite of difficulties and challenges to open hearts produces baptism and being added to the church (Ac 2:47; 8:9-40). It is powerful (Heb 4:12).



The world is consumed in darkness and desperately needs the Light [only] given by God. Do not horde, hide or hinder it, but — high-beam it! What is our vision for 2020? It should be just as clear as ever: seek and save the lost (Mt 18:11; Mk 16:15, 16; Lk 19:10; Jn 9:39-41; 1 Tim 1:13-16; Heb 6:4-8; 10:26-29; 7:25; 1 Jn 4:9-14).

## THINGS TO HELP US LIVE FOR THE LORD Zechariah 1:2 – 6

## INTRODUCTION:

- 1. In the book of Zechariah, several distinctive things will assist us to live for the Lord.
- 2. In this lesson [we] will discover four of these things in the book of Zechariah.

### BODY:

## 1. A HIGH REGARD FOR GOD'S PURPOSE IN THE WORLD

- A. From these verses it appears Zechariah was impressed with the part God's prophets had played in giving the divine message to the world (Mt 23:20; Ac 7:52).
  - 1. Although these prophets had died, God's Purpose was still unfulfilled and clearly binding upon Israel (Zec 1:5; 2 Pet 3:2 4).
- B. God wanted His Representatives to repent and turn away from their wickedness, which had destroyed their fathers (Zec 1:3; Ac 15:9; 2 Cor 7:1; Jas 4:8–10; 1 Pet 1:22; 1 Jn 3:3).
- C. He was able to sense the meaning of God's Will for His People (Zec 1:6; Mt 24:25).
  - 1. To him, God's Word was more than a storehouse of ancient history.
    - A. Instead, it was an ever present witness to the living presence of God.
- D. Zechariah saw God's Purpose was to assist His Children as they turn to Him.

## 2. THE WORLD WIDE REACH OF GOD'S NEW KINGDOM TO COME

- A. Up until this time, and on into the future, His Kingdom was limited to the house of Israel.
- B. However, there was to come a kingdom whose borders would be worldwide.
  - 1. Zechariah caught something of the Spirit of the great prophet to the exiles (Ezekiel), and predicted the full growth and extent of the kingdom that was to come.
- C. Instead of a city built on the old foundation/religion corresponding exactly to the preexilic pattern, Zechariah conceived the plan of God as embracing a multitude of people.
  - 1. It had its central purpose a Spiritual religion to influence individuals to be like the Lord in thought, word and deed (Job 15:8; 22:2; 40:2; Isa 40:13, 14; Jer 23:18).
- D. At least four passages in Zechariah help us see this point (Zec 2:11; 6:15; 8:23; 14:8, 9).
- E. May [we] quickly recall the words of Jesus to the woman at the well (Jn 4:20-24).

## 3. THE COMING MESSIAH

- A. Zechariah's picture of the coming Messiah stirs the soul (Zec 9:9, 10),
  - 1. This great King is to come as the Prince of Peace vindicated, victorious and lowly.
- B. He comes triumphantly, yet peacefully.
  - 1. Instead of a war horse, he rides the humble beast used by kings on missions of peace.
- C. Scriptures noteworthy of study (Zec 2:10; 3:8-10; 6:12, 13; 9:9, 10; 12:10; 13:7).
- D. In the New Testament [we] find numerous passages showing the fulfillment and thoughts of Zechariah (Jn 15:15; 16:13-16; 17; 6-8; Rom 11:34; Eph 3:3, 4; 1 Cor 2:12}
  - 1. Truly, He was the Prince of Peace (Jn 14:27; Ac 10:36; Eph 2:14-18; Col 1:20, 21).

## 4. DIVINE SOVEREIGNITY

- A. Sovereignty: being the supremacy, the unlimitedness of God's Power (Zec 14:7-11).
- B. Jesus was to soon be born king over all earth (Mt 2:2; Rev 19:16).
  - 1. He would bring into existence an eternal kingdom, Him as King, to be world-wide
  - 2. He would be supreme ruler of it until...it is returned to God (Mt 28:18; 1 Cor 15:24).

## **CONCLUSION:**

A. Let's be part of this worldwide, Spiritual Kingdom OBEYING the gospel (2 The 2:14).
