Those who choose to listen and obey the Gospel message SHALL be saved (Acts 2:38). God adds them to the Church of the Bible which His Son is coming for one day (2 The 1: 7 - 10)







PRAYERS TO GOD

The Bible says, "And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. Confess *your* faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much" (Jas 5:15, 16). We know He hears and answers the prayers of His children (Mt 7:7-11). Even when one is weak, weary and without hope, no longer knowing how or what to pray for, God still hears, helps and gives one the strength to bear up while bursting through their worst of conflicts as more than conquerors in Christ (Rom 8:24-39).

It probably goes without saying, many are praying daily for a very swift, specific and sudden conclusion to this COVID-19 chaos to get our lives back to some degree of normalcy (if you will). Perhaps, not visually seeing many positive results from those prayers, one may be tempted to think God is not listening (Mt 21:22) or our prayers as His blood-bought children are not reaching Him for some reason (Mt 17:20; 21:21; Mk 11:22, 23; Lk 17:6, 7; Rom 4:19, 20; 1 Cor 13:2; Jas 1:6).

If living in accordance with His Word having grown a bit weary and/or ready to give up praying because of a lack of visual, positive or tangible results, then understand this: if not witnessing positive results in response to

your prayers, it does not mean God is not listening; His Purposes have not yet been accomplished (Mt 5:11, 12; Ac 20:24; Rom 8:18; 2 Cor 4:17, 18; Col 3:4; 2 The 1:6-12; 1 Pet 1:6, 7, 13).

Do you remember the souls of the saints, slain for their faithfulness, who cried out from under the altar, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth" (Rev 6:9, 10). God's answer? It was going to be "a little while longer" because all He wanted was not yet "completed" (Rev 6:11). What about the Apostle Paul (2 Cor 12:7-10). He repeatedly prayed for his "thorn in the flesh" would be removed. God heard his prayer because of His response to it, but He did not remove Paul's thorn because He had something far better in mind for him (Mt 10:19, 20; Lk 21:15; 1 Cor 10:13; 15:10; Col 1:28, 29; 1 Tim 1:14; Heb 4:16).

Then, there is Christ "...Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending..." (Rev 1:8) – the perfect, sinless, flawless Son of the living God. Praying both fervently and repeatedly "...O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt" (Mt 26:39) and "...O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done" (Mt 26:42) for God to utilize another way for Him other than the cross (Mt 26:36-44). Without a doubt, God heard His Prayers, "Who in the days of

his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared; Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;" (Heb 5:7-9). No matter how difficult the ordeal to endure (Heb 12:1-3), possessing unlimited reasons why not giving His Son's Heartfelt Prayers a simple "YES" (Jn 8:32; Rom 5:1-11; Gal 3:26, 27).

Are you not grateful our Father in heaven is wise and loving enough, to know when to say "No" or "You must wait just a little while longer" in order to accomplish His Purposes (Rom 8:28), whatever they may be? Then pray without ceasing (1 The 5:17) and just TRUST Him like Jesus did! To confirm how true He is, follow the model of Paul (Eph 3:4, 9, 10) and GROW in His Love (Isa 40:26-31; Col 1:10,16, 17; 1 Pet 2:2; 2 Pet 3:18).
