#### A PSALM OF FEAR AND FAITH PSALMS 56:1 - 13

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

- 1. Does this appear to be a PRAYER of commonality?
- 2. This PRAYER begins several of the psalms. Who among us would not want God to be gracious?
- 3. David is detained in Gath by the Philistines (1 Sam 21:11-16; 27-29).
  - A. Like a dove in a strange land whose captivity gives rise to a mixture of "...FEAR and FAITH".

#### **BODY:**

#### 1. BE MERCIFUL UNTO ME

- A. It may seem like mankind is just trampling on us all day long; but, this is not actually happening.
- B. The Philistines oppressing David on this occasion seems unlimited (1 Sam 29:2-9).
  - 1. How encouraging it is to see the sweet Spirit of psalmist plead to the mercy of God for assistance.

#### 2. I WILL TRUST IN THEE

- A. This is the meaning of crying out to God. It is trusting in Him; praising His Word; more than verbal.
  - 1. Standing tall, God at your back facing the enemy w/ the attitude: "what can mere man do to me?"
- B. David was NO coward nor given to false fearlessness. What gives him the confidence to trust in God?
- C. In times of distress, we are driven by God's Word knowing with fidelity He Will keep His Promise.
- D. Who are we to fear what flesh can do to us? We can not give what is not within us to give.
  - 1. Lk 6:46; Rom 15:4; 2 Cor 5:7; Gal 1:10; 2 Tim 2:15; 1 Pet 4:11; 2 Pet 1:3, 5-14, 20, 21
- E. Have a plan of attack the next time you feel the whole world is against you.
- F. The enemy is not the one you may think is after you or persecuting you. Your enemy is the devil.
  - 1. The way to face the enemy is to follow the Apostle Paul's advice: "And whatsoever ye do, do *it* heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ" (Col 3:23, 24).

#### 3. THEY MARK MY STEPS

- A. All who live righteously should expect those who do not to continually extort the correct meaning.
- B. The oppressors lay an ambush being entirely bent on doing evil; so in fear and frustration, we cry out!!
- C. God will judge the oppressors by His Word (Jn 12:48).

#### 4. WHEN I CRY UNTO THEE

- A. Just as the Philistines mark David's step, God observes every detail they are making.
- B. God is equally paying due diligence unto David because of His acknowledgment: "for God is for me".
- C. Are we able to witness the precise and exact interest God shows us on a daily basis? (Isa 12:2)

#### 5. IN GOD HAVE I PUT MY TRUST

- A. Fear has been swallowed up in faith, the time has come to praise God (Psa 100:1-5).
- B. David says, "I will not be afraid what man can do unto me" (Heb 13:6).
- C. David is convinced with God on his side, he has become the majority.

#### 6. I WILL RENDER PRAISE UNTO THE

- A. Under the direction of affliction, David has made a vow of thankfulness to God.
- B. Making vows are commendable only if fulfillment follows (Psa 56:12; Pro 20:25).
- C. Often we are willing to make these vows, but quickly forget or unwilling to honor.
  - 1. David resolves he will not forget to fulfill his sincere acknowledgement of preserving life's path.
- D. God snatched him from the jaws of death (Rom 6:23; 7:24).
- E. Notice this traumatic experience and how he heavily relied on God [continually] to preserve him.
- F. David's Spiritual Maturity is expressed on continued reliance to walk in the light of the living.
  - 1. Lk 18:43; 19:37; 1 Cor 4:5; Eph 1:6, 14; Php 1:11; 4:8; Heb 2:12; 13:15; 1 Pet 1:7; Rev 19:5
