RUNNING THE CHRISTIAN RACE 2 TIMOTHY 4:7

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Paul often compares the Christian LIFE to an athletic event (1 Cor 9:24-27; Php 1:30; 1 Tim 6:20).
- 2. The Christian LIFE is a daily commitment to follow Jesus (Lk 9:23).
 - A. A race which must be completed (Heb 12:1, 2).
 - 1. To be partakers of Christ, we must "...if we hold from the beginning—until the end;" (Heb 3:14).
 - 2. The runner has no chance of victory without crossing the finish line.
 - A. Similarly, the Christian must be faithful until death to receive the crown of LIFE (Rev 2:10).

BODY:

1. FOUGHT A GOOD FIGHT


- A. Paul is not boasting of what he had done, BUT having spent his life in the good fight or contest.
 - 1. The good fight is compared to a wrestling match, boxing bout or similar contest (1 Tim 4:12).
 - 2. Being a struggle, God expects His Children to do what is right while doing one's BEST.
- B. To "fight" is to be involved in the athletic contest. This is what Paul had done and Christians must do.
- C. To have "fought" implies a completed action expressing one's confidence.

2. FINISHED MY COURSE

- A. The word "course" refers to a race track.
 - 1. Paul uses the athletic metaphor describing John the Baptist (Ac 13:25) and himself (Ac 20:24).
- B. The word "finished" refers to having accomplished, which is difficult to achieve.
 - 1. Notice what was revealed: he had finished. He did **NOT** quit!!
 - A. To have a successful life is to accomplish what God reveals to be relevant.
- C. This is the same word used by Jesus after accomplishing His Mission on the cross (Jn 19:28, 30).
 - 1. The Christian LIFE is **NOT** a 100-yard dash, BUT a marathon with an obstacle course.

3. KEPT THE FAITH


- A. FAITH is defined (Heb 11:1) and impossible to please God without (Heb 11:6).
 - 1. This is **NOT** personal in Christ, BUT the whole body of Christian TRUTH [doctrine].
- B. This clause may be understood in 3 ways:
 - 1. I have kept the rules of the game of LIFE.
 - A. I have played the game.
 - 2. I have kept the conditions of the contract.
 - A. I have been true to Christ and my commitment.
 - 3. In the face of all the obstacles, I have never lost hope and trust in Jesus Christ. Paul intended all of these.
- C. Like the runner lunging forward with one last ounce of strength to reach the finish line, so the Christian must run in like manner as to win the race of LIFE (1 Cor 9:24).
- D. We must give our hearts in steadfast devotion to God.
 - 1. All God requires is we put forth our best effort.
 - 2. We stumble and falter at times, BUT must get back in the race concentrating on our BEST for the Master.
- E. The race is set before us. Our goal is heaven.
 - 1. The strength needed comes from the Lord.
 - A. But, we must do the running every step of the way.
