

THE JOY OF GIVING Nehemiah 8:10

INTRODUCTION:

- The reason [we] can "Rejoice in the Lord always" (Php 4:4) is because of an altered state of mind.
 A. Instead of growing into a state of discontent due to the things <u>NOT</u> in our possession; [we] decide to focus on the many things received from the Giver of every good and perfect gift (Ac 13:17; Jas 1:17).
 The ultimate good God wants for everyone is to become a righteous person and go to heaven.
 - B. It is <u>NOT</u> for MAN to control their circumstances, BUT lives righteously under those circumstances BELIEVING, TRUSTING and OBEYING God knowing His Ultimate, Spiritual Purpose will prevail.

BODY:

1. THE JOY OF THE LORD IS OUR STRENGTH

- A. Remember the deeper, more abiding "JOY" is in GIVING rather than RECEIVING.1. This is indicated by our Lord, "It is more blessed to give than to receive" (Ac 20:35).
- B. A selfish, spoiled-brat attitude is <u>NOT</u> conducive to living a happy, productive, Christian LIFE.
 - 1. As His Children, [we] have the unique privilege of viewing all things in their most positive light.
 - 2. The Beloved Apostle Paul reminds us, "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to *his* purpose" (Rom 8:28).
 - 3. This important piece of information enables us to, "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (1 The 5:18).
- C. ONLY in Christ can Spiritual BLESSINGS in heavenly places be found (Eph 1:3).
- D. Even when things do **NOT** appear to be going our way and anxious thoughts arise in our hearts, are [we] able to turn it over to Him because He Cares for US (1 Pet 5:7).
- E. In the midst of darkening shadows, Paul tells us to "Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God" (Php 4:6).
- F. The result of incomprehensible peace is a BLESSING the world can neither give nor take (Jn 14:27).
 - 1. The focus of our thinking/predominant pattern of our life must be on GIVING, NOT receiving.
 - 2. St. Francis of Assisi is attributed to having said, "It is in giving that we receive".
- G. A heart changed forever by the gift of Calvary (Jn 3:16) ALWAYS looking for opportunities to give.
 1. This brings us back to a full circle as to what the Lord said in "...give than to receive" (Ac 20:35).
- H. Like the 1st Century Macedonians, [we] should long for the BLESSING of participating in the support of those in need (2 Cor 8:1-4). How can one explain such unselfish joy in the midst of abject poverty?
 I. The Scripture explains "they first gave themselves to the Lord" (2 Cor 8:5).

 1. Concerning the act of giving, [we] open ourselves up to the wonderful, unending possibilities for JOY and FULFILLMENT in this LIFE as well as in the AGE to come (Eph 2:7).
