food for thought

FAITHFUL SAYINGS

Psalms 143:7, 8

INTRODUCTION:

1. Due to the Psalmist's desperate situation with his overwhelming and failing Spirit, he PRAYS.
 - A. God is **NOT** only his first resort in his TIME of trouble, **BUT** [equally] his last!!
2. Being in a TIME where to TRUST someone's word is at a premium being difficult for us **NOT** to change.
3. It should be obvious to ALL of God's Word being TRUTH (Jn 8:32; 17:17; 1 The 2:13; Tit 1:1; 3 Jn 4).
 - A. The Psalmist would be illuminated by God in such a way as to perceive the right course to follow.

BODY:

1. FOR IN THEE DO I TRUST

- A. "This is a faithful saying" or "faithful is the word" refers to this saying as trustworthy/reliable/believe.
 1. "This *is* a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief" (1 Tim 1:15).
 2. "This *is* a true saying, If a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work" (1 Tim 3:1).
 3. "This *is* a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance" (1 Tim 4:9).
 4. "*It is* a faithful saying: For if we be dead with *him*, we shall also live with *him*." (2 Tim 2:11).
 5. "*This is* a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men" (Tit 3:8).
- B. Christ's Purpose of coming was to save sinners (Lk 19:10; Jn 3:16; Eph 1:4-14; 1 Pet 1:18-23).
 1. For God desires all men to be saved (2 Pet 3:9). No one is beyond the GRACE of God.
- C. Paul perpetrated acts against God and Christians; yet, obtained mercy (1 Tim 1:13).
 1. The GRACE of God and ETERNAL LIFE are conditional (Lk 6:46; Rev 22:14).
 2. I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me..." (Gal 2:20).
 - A. It is a truth, if we endure with Jesus the Christ unto the end, we shall be saved (Rev 2:10).
 - B. "For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come" (1 Tim 4:8).
 1. While there might be a little profit in the discipline of the body, it pales in comparison to the benefit of godliness. It is a blessing for this present life and the life to come.
 3. "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them" (Eph 2:8-10).
 4. "They profess that they know God; but in works they deny *him*, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate" (Tit 1:16).
- D. The Apostle Peter instructs Christians to live holy/righteous lives; hoping for a new heaven and earth.
 1. "As also in all *his* epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as *they do* also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction. Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know *these things* before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own steadfastness" (2 Pet 3:15).
- E. May we consider these faithful sayings in our daily service to the Lord (Lk 9:23).
